Terminology

Double meaning

- **LibreOffice** is
 - 1. the leading free office productivity suite installed by millions of users worldwide
 - 2. a wonderful worldwide **community** ("project") with hundreds of friends and contributors around the globe
- ▼ The Document Foundation (TDF) as legal entity is
 - a nonprofit "Stiftung" (foundation) based in Berlin "The objective of the foundation is the promotion and development of office software available for use by anyone free of charge"
 - does **not contain a product name** on purpose



Our philosophy

- supporting the **development** of both product <u>and</u> community events, knowledge sharing, mentoring
- built on the community's values and ideals through statutes that enforce openness and transparency
- ▼ independent from one <u>single</u> sponsor 70,000+ individual donations per year
- ecosystem for contributors and commercial stakeholders certification, joint development efforts
- **▼** lower **entry barriers:** Easy Hacks, Hackfests, GSoC mentoring, workshops
- **cooperations** with other entities: e.g. OASIS, OSI, KDE, GNOME, FSFE, FSF
- ¬ → "by the community, for the community"



The Foundation

Why all this fuss?

- enduring and stable ("foundations are for eternity")
- foundation's objective can not be changed
- **safety** for community, end-users and the ecosystem
- acts as "trustee" for trademarks and domains
- handles donations and manages budgets
- ▼ is not part of the commercial ecosystem itself
- **guarantees rights** for <u>all</u> participants




How we are structured

Board of Directors

foundation's legal representative

7 members and 3 deputies, term of 2 years from around the globe, currently: Italy, UK, Germany, Netherlands, Taiwan, Czech Republic

election of board



Board of Trustees ("Members")

currently 193 <u>individuals</u> working on foundation's goals - approved for one year, once per quarter - active in community for 3 months, 6 more planned, **donations do not qualify**



The Advisory Board

- Advisory Board supports and advises Board of Directors
- companies and organizations (no individuals) with
 - either direct connection to LibreOffice
 - or long experience with FLOSS
- based on sponsorship
- currently 16 members
- one meeting with the board per quarter
- non-confidential slides shared with our trustees afterwards



Public by default


In the statutes

- "one-third rule" to prevent conflict of interest
- openness and transparency
 - all board meetings are public https://wiki.documentfoundation.org/TDF/BoD_Meetings
 - all decisions of the bodies are public https://wiki.documentfoundation.org/TDF/BoD_Decisions
 - the accounting is public
 https://wiki.documentfoundation.org/TDF/Ledgers
 - the board's mailing list is public private decisions are made public as soon as the confidentiality is resolved






LibreOffice

- leading free office suite for Windows, Linux and macOS
- available in more than 100 languages ("digital participation")
- ▼ time-based releases: two major releases per year, bugfixes ~6 weeks
- **two versions** (as of now 6.0 and 5.4) maintained, plus **Android Viewer**
- **▼ LibreOffice 6.1** ~Jul: usability features, online improvements, icon sets

LibreOffice Online



https://hub.docker.com/r/libreoffice/online/

- runs natively in the **browser**
- integrates with storage & auth
- collaborative editing
- same rendering of documents as desktop version
- Docker container available

Document Liberation Project

- filter for legacy and proprietary formats
- removes vendor lock-in

Document Liberation
Own your content

- ▼ gives users access again to their data
- provides a path towards the Open Document Format
- made by volunteers during LibreOffice development
- ▼ library now used in many other open source projects
- ▼ in line with TDF's mission and FLOSS ideals

Our annual report

- **jointly** written with the community in EN+DE
- turned our legal obligation into a benefit
