Terminology

Double meaning

- **▼ LibreOffice** is
 - 1. the leading free (as in speech <u>and</u> beer) office productivity suite used by over 210 million people worldwide

The Document Foundation

- 2. a worldwide community ("project") with hundreds of contributors from around the globe
- ▼ The Document Foundation (TDF) as legal entity is
 - a nonprofit "Stiftung" (foundation) based in Berlin "The objective of the foundation is the **promotion and development** of **office software**available for use by **anyone**"
 - does **not contain a product name** on purpose



Our philosophy

- support the development of **both software** <u>and</u> **community** *events, knowledge sharing, infrastructure*
- built on the community's values and ideals through statutes that vouch for openness and transparency
- **▼ independent** from one **single** sponsor thanks to the support of many
- ecosystem for contributors and commercial stakeholders certification, joint development efforts
- **▼** lower **entry barriers**: *Easy Hacks, Hackfests, mentoring, workshops*
- cooperation with other entities: e.g. OASIS, OSI, FSFE


How we are structured

Board of Directors

foundation's legal representative

7 members and 2 deputies, term of 2 years from around the globe, currently: France, Hungary, United Kingdom, Brazil, Italy, Luxembourg, Germany

(re-)election of volunteer board



committee

Board of Trustees ("Members")

currently 174 <u>individuals</u> working on foundation's goals - approved for one year, once per quarter - **meritocracy**: active in community for 3 months, 6 more planned, **donations do not qualify**



What the Foundation is about

- enduring and stable ("built for eternity")
- foundation's objective can not be changed
- ▼ safety for community, end-users and the ecosystem
- acts as "trustee" for trademarks and domains
- handles donations and manages budgets
- is not part of the commercial ecosystem itself
- **guarantees rights** for <u>all</u> participants



Public by default

In the statutes

- **▼ "one-third rule"** to prevent conflict of interest
- openness and transparency
 - all board meetings are public https://community.documentfoundation.org/tags/c/board-discuss/26/minutes
 - all decisions of the bodies are public https://community.documentfoundation.org/tags/c/board-discuss/26/decision
 - the accounting is public https://wiki.documentfoundation.org/TDF/Ledgers
 - the board's mailing list is public https://community.documentfoundation.org/c/board-discuss/26
 private decisions are public as soon as confidentiality is resolved



Our annual report

- jointly written with the community in English and German
- turned our legal obligation into a marketing activity

Lessons learned

Food for thought

- money is needed, contributor time is invaluable
- transparency requires a lot of effort, but is key
- legal obligations grow and can become a challenge
- things you don't understand can be important
- trust is the anchor of open source and free software
- ▼ the human side of things cannot be underestimated
